2. Treasurer's Report: Jack gave the treasurer's report and stated that we have about \$14,073 in our account. We are still trying to sell the remaining car wash tickets. We spent \$2028 on the Wildwood tournament. We will still need to pay printing for program, away & home meals, concession bills, senior nite, youth nite and banquet.
3. Team Apparel: Mark reported for Melissa on team apparel. All team apparel has been distributed except for a few backordered items. They should be in about 6 days. There are some extras in a few items and if you'd like to purchase any item please email Melissa. Thanks to Melissa for all her work.
4. Car Wash Tickets: Jack reported for Monica on the status of the car wash fundraiser. We paid John Kunhs but we still have some tickets to sell. We will have them available at the spirit stand during home games. Thanks to Monica for all her hard work.
5. Program: Dawn reported that we still have a few patrons that owe for their ads. She is trying to distribute to the sponsors that checked the box to receive a copy of the program. We will make about \$6400 in profit on the program. She is also still making the Game Day Brochures for each home game. Thanks to Joe Todaro for doing all the copying. Youth Nite and Senior Nite will be copied in color. Thanks to Dawn for doing the program and all the endless hours she put in to make it a success.
6. Middle School Lunch: Dawn reported that OMS will have their lunch at Rascals Saturday 1/16 and SMS 1/23. They will set up a buffet and also get a \$5 game card. The bus can't take the players to Rascals so they will have to get rides from the school to Rascals. Parents are invited to stay and can order off the menu on their own. She will have tables set up for the team also parents/siblings. Menu will be : Pizza, wings, sliders & fries, and sodas.

9. Senior Nite: MaryAnn Kelley will run Senior Nite and has sent out emails to collect information. Feb. 12th is our last home game and seniors and parents will be announced right after the JV game. Dawn will order posters of the basketball seniors. We will hang them prior to the game and then give as a senior gift.
10. By Laws: By Laws Revisions: Jack brought up a revision to change booster club dues to \$30 per family for the next basketball season. The minutes read: The amount of the next annual dues will be placed on the ballot and voted on at the March Election Meeting.
