

Parkland Boys Basketball Booster Club Minutes: April 1, 2009

1. Approval of Minutes, 1st by Jack Karabasz and seconded by Tim Miller.
2. Treasurer's Report: Jack gave the treasurer's report and stated that our balance is about \$16,000. We still need money for the upcoming banquet, banquet gifts, replacement jerseys, frames, team camp etc. The food services bill from the high school and the concession stand food from Willow Tree Grove have been paid. We will have to see how much we need for next year and may need a fundraiser to increase the funds.
3. Banquet: Jill ordered the 7 replacement jerseys and they will be framed by Charles Angels. Dawn has the sweatpants to be given out for the gifts. We will get the trainers gift certificates instead of sweatpants. The dinner will be an Italian style with chicken parm, pasta etc. Jill asked if we could print 8 x 10 photos of the district championship for the varsity team. All agreed. The district 11 shirts will be purchased for \$10 each and will be printed on the back. These shirts will be given to the varsity team, coaches as well. Dawn and Jill will create the banquet program. Sean Ward will make sure the hi-light video is at Willow Tree. We will invite Dr. Donohue, Dr. Novey, Principal Sniscak, Rich Fatzinger, Lonnie the scorekeeper, Don Herb, Gina Mihalik and the alumni club as special guests. Greg Mitton mentioned that the girl's booster club did their banquet at Muhlenberg College this year. It was \$15 per person and they did a nice job. Just a suggestion for the future.
7. Dues: Any change in booster club dues must be brought up at this meeting and voted upon. Jack suggested to increase the dues for next season from \$20/family to \$25/family. The vote was approved by all.
8. Player Meals: Sarah brought up an idea for next year for the away games. She researched different possibilities. The price range was from \$ 5 - \$8 per player. Sarah will arrange this for next year. We took a vote and agreed that we would try the meals for away games. Sarah will keep the price to \$5 or \$6 a player with sandwich and drink and choose the vendor we will use for next year.
9. AAU Tournament: Greg sent our emails and distributed flyers for our June 6 & 7 AAU basketball tournament. The tournament is open to girls and boys teams. Karen Pammer will be our coordinator for the refs. We will pay the refs \$30 per game. Jill will coordinate volunteers and food. We need to get the word out to

get more teams to sign up. Set up will be Friday June 5th.

10. New Business: Dawn reported that Andy ordered the District championship jackets. If needed we will cover any extra cost with embroidering. JV & Varsity will participate in only ONE summer league this year. The summer league games are at Cedar Beach courts.
