

Parkland Boys Basketball Booster Club Minutes: Feb. 18, 2010

1. Approval of Minutes, 1<sup>st</sup> by Sara Karabasz & 2nd by Kim Brannan.
2. Hoop Group: Jim gave a wrap up of Hoop Group. We had 2 refrigerators with 25 cases of drinks per frig. The concessions went well. He would like to see Parkland have the 3rd game instead of the last game to keep the crowd there until the end. Andy said he has already spoken to them about this for next year. Also we need to tell them that people were unhappy with not being able to leave and come back to the games without paying another entrance fee. Thanks to Jim for a good job.
3. Senior Night: MaryAnn Kelley said all went well. The seniors loved their posters and we will try to put them under the Trojan pack for next year. Thanks to MaryAnn and Dawn for senior night.
4. Dues: A vote was made to increase the booster club dues to \$30 per family for the next basketball season.
5. Away Game Meals: Sara reported that the away meals came to a cost of only \$2.92 per person after taking into account the Wegmans gift card. She spent a total of \$553 and purchased 224 meals. Wegmans won't discount food, but will donate to the club by way of gift card. She picked up the sandwiches around 2:00 and cut them up. Tim provided the drinks.
6. OMS/SMS Game: The game will be held on Feb. 24th at the high school. The pizza party will be held after the game. The dance team, cheerleaders will perform.
7. Banquet/Year End Event: Coach met with the six seniors and other coaches to discuss what they would prefer for a year end event. They decided they would buy tickets to a basketball game, maybe Villanova and then go out to dinner. We will provide transportation to and from the event. We will need to decide when and where we will show the high light video and present the seniors with their framed jerseys.
8. Parkland Gives Back: Jack reported that we had a good amount of food to donate to the 2nd harvest food bank. It was probably less than what we could have collected, but due to the game being snowed out twice the donations were forgotten. We had collected 30 tickets in the concession stand for the free hot dog or soft pretzel.
9. AAU Summer Tournament: The tournament is booked for Jun 5 & 6. Greg registered the event on the AAU web site and Jill put the registration form on our parkland

basketball web site. The tournament includes girls and boys ages 12 - 17. The price is \$375/team. Last year we made about \$12,000. This is great fundraiser for the basketball team. We need to encourage volunteer participation. Andy can get clocks and will also encourage the players to work that weekend. Karen Pammer will coordinate the refs for the weekend. We will set up Friday night 6/4 and the event will end around 6:00 Sunday night.

10. Treasurer's Report: Jack reported that we have \$16,425 in our account as of now. We still have to pay Willow Tree Dinners, Snack Stand food, Parent's Night charge, Pizza party for middle school, varsity gifts and event, high light video etc. Hoop Group brought in \$2278 in concessions and \$1149 in drink sales. We still need the bill from Coke.
11. Nominations: Kim Brannan is nominated for Vice President, Kelly Rosario for Secretary, Ted Charles for Treasurer. No nomination has been made for President.
12. Car Wash Tickets: Tim reported that we still have about 30 outstanding car wash tickets. Dawn has about 25 left but will try to sell them. We still need to collect some tickets from middle school parents.
13. New Business: Andy said that he will be picking a team camp for the summer. He is planning on having a holiday basketball tournament at the high school.
