

Parkland Boys Basketball Booster Club Minutes: May 21, 2009

1. Approval of Minutes, 1<sup>st</sup> by Jack Karabasz and seconded by Melissa Sutovich.
2. Treasurer's Report: Jack gave the treasurer's report and stated that our balance is about \$4690. We paid for the banquet, video, gifts and we are very low in our balance. We hope our AAU tournament will bring our balance over \$10,000. We will also need some fundraisers.
3. Banquet: Jill reported that the banquet went well. The Italian dinner was better for the kids. We will need to increase the banquet dollar amount to cover more of our expenses. We discussed increasing the dinner to \$20/ person instead of \$10/person. Schaeffer video is adding the district 11 championship on the end of the video. He will make copies for the varsity team and coaches.
7. AAU Tournament: Greg reported that we have about 35 teams in the tournament. He thinks we will have to drop a few of the girls brackets due to not enough teams. We will set up Friday June 5th at 5pm. He has enough clocks. Jill will organize the concession stand and send out a volunteer schedule for all areas needed. Karen Pammer is organizing the refs. We have enough shirts from last year to hand out to the winning teams.
8. Sumer League: Coach handed out a schedule for varsity summer league. He will put a varsity and jv team in the stellar tournament. He will also register us for the Sports Fest Tournament. Varsity will play Tuesday and Thursdays at Cedar Beach and the two JV teams will play Sunday nites at Cedar Beach.
9. Team Camp: Coach didn't find a camp that interested him at this point. He may suggest that the varsity and JV participate in the DeSales camp.
10. Winter Tournament: Coach suggested that we consider going to the KSA Disney Basketball Tournament and that the girls team is probably going as well. There was much discussion about this tournament due to the expense. A vote will have to be made after the 1st summer league games as to whether we will go and how we will raise the money. We estimated that the cost would be around \$16,000. Most varsity parents felt that the cost was too much.

11. Fundraising: We will sell the car wash tickets thru Kuhnsville Car Wash as a summer fundraiser. Monica Miller will coordinate this fundraiser. Hopefully we can make about \$2000 on this fundraiser. Kim Brannan will also look into other options for fundraising.
12. New Business: We need to set aside money for the winter basketball tournament separate from our regular bank account. This way we will have the money available for future tournaments.
