1. Approval of Minutes, 1st by Kim Brannan & 2nd by Ann Case.
2. Treasurer's Report: Ted reported on the bank statement. Our new bank will be Embassy Bank. He will set up the account with the new officers. Our balance is at \$8400.
3. Team Camp: The varsity team camp will probably be at Princeton this June. Coach will have to give us the cost and dates.
4. Summer League: Summer league begins early June. The varsity plays Tues. and Thurs. at Cedar Beach courts. We put two teams in the Sunday night summer league. A suggestion was made to add a 3rd team to the Sunday night league since we have such a large incoming freshman boys team. Jim Carlon will ask Coach if we can add a 3rd team. Summer league fees will be paid by the booster club. Kim Brannan will be the person in charge of communicating to the middle school parents/players with details of summer league. All players are to wear their practice jerseys for summer league. Jim Zajko said he has contacted Coach about a possible Donofrio Tournament next April.
Our Christmas tournament will be at Parkland this year. Coach is trying to get 4 teams to play over 12/28 and 12/29.
5. AAU Summer Tournament: The tournament is booked for Jun 5 & 6. Greg registered the event on the AAU web site and Jill put the registration form on our parkland basketball web site. The tournament includes girls and boys ages 12 - 17. The price is \$375/team. Last year we made about \$12,000 and had 40 teams. This is great fundraiser for the basketball team. We need to encourage volunteer participation. We are very low for this time. We need to get the word out and hand out forms to encourage participation. If we don't get enough teams we will have to cancel the tournament and figure out another fundraiser to make money. Jill will handle the concession stand and volunteer schedule closer to the time. Karen Pammer will coordinate the refs for the weekend. The championship teams will receive a T-shirt instead of a trophy.
6. New Business: Jim Carlon thanked the previous board and handed a gift to each of them!! Thank you to the booster club!!!
